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POLICE PERSONNEL

PART TIME OFFICERS

The Police Department currently employs five (5) Part Time Police Officers. These Officers perform the same duties as the full time Police Officers. The part time officers are a necessity for the Police Department. Thanks to the part time Officers the Village has 24 hour coverage each day of the year. A Part time officer is scheduled to work 8 hours per week in order for the Village to have the 24 hour coverage. Part time officers also fill in for the full time officers when they take vacation, sick days, training, emergency situations and assist the full time officers with the Firemen's festival.

In 2011 the Part Time Police Officers worked at total of **2894 hrs**. The Village spent **\$33281.00** in wages for the part time police officers services. Part-time officers are paid \$11.50 per hour with no benefits.

Two part-time officers are considered **permanent part-time** officers. This was necessary to replace the full time officer hours that was not replaced after resignation in July 2010. The **permanent part-time hours and days each week** are as follows:

Officer Lemmeyer and Officer Gibson are the current permanent part-time officers.

The remaining **non permanent part-time officers** are required to work a minimum of 75 hours per year.

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FULL TIME OFFICERS

The Village of Greenwich employees three (3) full time Police Officers. Chief of Police and two (2) Patrol Officers. Each Officer works a 40 hour work week throughout any given year. Because of the 24 hour coverage, some officers do not have the idea hours and days off. Full time Officers do on an occasion have to work overtime. The overtime consists of Court duty, investigations; fill in for officers when sick or on vacation and the Firemen's Festival. In 2011 two (2) full time Police Officers worked a total of 706 hrs in overtime. Police Officers are paid \$16.20 per hour and 1½ times the regular rate if work more than 80 hours in two weeks. The Chief of Police wage is \$19.97 per hour with no overtime compensation in money. The following is a breakdown of overtime that two full time officers worked.

RESERVE OFFICERS

The Greenwich Police Department has a reserve unit. These officers are Certified Police Officers through the State of Ohio. They have the same arrest powers as the full time and part time officers. The Reserve officer does not receive compensation from the Village. When they work as a police officer their time is voluntary. The Police Department currently has three (3) Reserve Officers.



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POLICE CRUISERS

The following are the current Police Cruisers for the Village of Greenwich.

- Unit # 2. Purchased September 22, 2010, 2008 (\$7534.50) mileage 53,310. 2008 Ford Crown Victoria Police Sedan
- Unit # 3. Purchased June 3, 2008 (\$4200.00) mileage 70,198 2005 Ford Crown Victoria Police Sedan
- Unit # 4. Purchased December 19, 2008 (\$8050.00, fully equipped) mileage 68,687 2006 Ford Crown Victoria Police Sedan

I assign each full-time officer to one cruiser. They are responsible for cleanliness, and maintenance of their assigned cruiser. The officers who live within the Village limits have the option of taking the cruiser to their residence after their shift is complete. The full-time officers are assigned to the following Units, which are identified by a Unit number on the rear plate and on the right front fender.

- Unit # 1 Part Time Officers
- Unit # 2 Officer Aaron Smith
- Unit # 3 Officer Robert Workman
- Unit # 4 Chief Dorsey

Officers of the Greenwich Police Department drove a total of **31844 miles** in 2011. The vehicles are used for patrolling the Village, Court appearances and when available to and from training.

The cost for the gasoline for cruisers in 2011 was **\$11648.59**. The cruisers used **3353 gallons** of gasoline. The average cost of gasoline for 2011 was **\$3.47 per gallon**. The average mileage per gallon of gasoline totaled **10 miles per gallon**. The poor mileage is contributed to slow speeds in the village, idling while running radar, cold weather and hot weather. Officers have been instructed to turn the cruiser off if they are out of the cruiser for long periods of time to save on gasoline consumption.

Cruiser maintenance cost were up slightly in 2011 due to Unit#2 2004 Ford with over 100000 miles. Approximately \$1000.00 was for front end replacement. Steering, tie rods etc. Unit #3 also had unforeseen costs. The headlights would not stay on. A senor located in the dash had to be replaced. The senor was \$600.00 and the labor total \$286.00 (\$886.00) Unit #3 also had



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Damaged to the right front fender and headlight. An Officer accidently struck a pole at the range while pulling out of the entrance.

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THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH POLICE ACTIVITY REPORTS

The following graphs represent the Police Activity by Officers from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. The following categories record the Officers activity.

- 1. Offense/ Incident Reports: These reports are criminal offenses, non criminal, and information only and arrest reports. A total of 265 incident reports were written.
- 2. Call Assignment Reports: These reports consist of everyday activity that requires a report. The reports range from civil matters, vehicle lock-out, assist motorist, dog complaint, alarms, open business door, found property, etc any report that is not a criminal offense. Officers wrote a total of 2123 call record reports in 2011.


Traffic Citations: In 2011 Greenwich Police Officers wrote 277 traffic violations. The majority of the citations were for exceeding the posted speed limits. Officer issued 121 warnings for traffic offenses.

Misdemeanor Summons: In 2011 Greenwich Police Officers wrote 59 summons. The majority of the summons were for disorderly conduct. This does not include the Complaints that Village Attorney Steve Palmer wrote for the Police department totaling 11 additional charges.

Traffic Accidents: In 2011 the Greenwich Police Department investigated 7 Traffic Accidents.



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TRAINING

On January 4, 2007 Ohio established legislation and created Ohio's Continuing Professional Training requirement. "All" certified Police Officers in the State of Ohio are required to have Continued Professional Training. To maintain your Police certification a Police Officer is mandated to complete three requirements in 2011:

- 1. Update training
- 2. Annual Firearms qualification
- 3. Continued Professional Training. (one hour)

The Police Officers at the Greenwich Police Department met all three requirements in 2011.

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NORWALK MUNICIPAL COURT REPORT

- In 2011 The Greenwich Police Department had 70 criminal arrests that resulted in 70 convictions through Norwalk Municipal Court. Greenwich Officer issued 59 summons and Law Director issued 11 criminal complaints.
- In 2011 The Greenwich Police Department had 277 Traffic violation arrests that resulted in 277 convictions.
- The Greenwich Police Department has 172 outstanding warrants for arrest of persons charged with a crime committed in Greenwich or warrants for failure to pay fines or serve jail time. Officer arrested 39 persons on warrants in 2011.
- The Greenwich Police Department accepted \$4361.00 in bonds and/or waivers for the Norwalk Municipal Court in 2011.
- In 2011 the Greenwich Police Department received \$11734.00 in traffic fines, \$5066.24 in criminal fines for a total of \$16800.24. This money is placed in the General Fund.



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PHYSICAL FITNESS IN 2011

In 2011 the Village Council passed legislation requiring all Police Officers to pass an approved Obstacle Course once each year. Failure to pass the course will result in termination of employment. The obstacle course is also a requirement for new applicants to pass before employment. The Police Department and Village council has recognized a need to have healthy Officers to help lower the cost of health insurance. The program is considered "preventive care".

The obstacle course consists of the following tasks.

- 1. Exit the Cruiser
- 2. Run 220 yards carrying a flash light
- 3. Obstacle Course
 - a. Go over a 42 inch wall
 - b. Jump hurdles, 16 inches, 24 inches and 12 inches
 - c. Weave around 9 cones 5 feet apart.
 - d. Crawl on the ground a distance of 10 feet in a enclosed area no higher than 24 inches
 - e. Run 50 feet to Dummy drag
- 4. Dummy Drag
 - a. Drag/carry 175 pound dummy 100 feet
- 5. Reverse Obstacle Course
- 6. Run 220 yards carrying flash light
- 7. Load firearm and fire 6 rounds left hand and six rounds right hand into a target. Officer must shoot 80% (2 misses allow) Failure to shoot 80% will disqualify the Officer and he/she must repeat the entire course again.
- 8. Return to vehicle.

The physical ability testing is a timed event. All tasks are to be completed in a total time of 7 minutes and 9 seconds. Failure to complete any task of the test will be disqualification. Officer must complete course again.

All Greenwich Police Officers passed the Physical Abilities Test in 2011.
