Calls were made to the Secretary of State were made to see if any forgiveness could be given. No revenue will be collected on the park and cemetery for next year due to this error and a new levy's will need to be created to be put on the ballot in May 2021. A considerable amount of revenue has been lost to the clerk's error.
