Chief's Report: Chief Dorsey states there have been some vehicles that have been ransacked through, suspects were caught on video and the PD is looking for them, he is going to post the video on Facebook, hoping that will get some feedback. PD has been very busy with a major incident that happened on Village property resulting in a death. The incident is under investigation as a criminal offense. The police department is sponsoring a free Thanksgiving Turkey Dinner as of right now there are 29 residents that have reached out and the Police Department are volunteering their time to deliver the meals. They will have on their protective gear set the meals on their door step. Regina Lueck is preparing the meals, she has been in home economics for years, while living in Texas. She has taken all the precautionary steps while preparing the food and will be serving them individual food containers. Residents have till the 19th to place their order and delivery is on November 21st between 11 am and 2 pm please go to the Village's website for more information. Dinner requests can be called into the Police Department. Mike Lloyd advised Chief that he has been receiving calls about loud mufflers again.

Zoning Inspector: Cles has caught a few people that have put fences up with no permit, he has tried to make contact with them. There are some houses that need to be better kept on S. Kniffin and a few cars that need removed. Chief said he would issue them a 5 day notice.

Solicitor's Report: Mayor stated Attorney Palmer wanted council to discuss whether they knew that the ordinances and resolutions could be put in the paper by title only and we could start posting full legislation on the website. Lynne Phillips states that it has been worked out with the newspaper and only the title will be published with a description of were the full copy can be seen.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Sallee states the Governor is placing a state wide curfew for 10 pm to 5 am for everyone in Ohio. The Mayor says that any of the people that are out rummaging through cars can possibly be arrested for a curfew violation as well. It is a possible \$750.00 fine and 90 days in jail. Chief will update him with news from EMA once he gets caught up on messages from them.
