ANNUAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE
(RC 5705.38)

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38(A) provides that on or about the first day of each fiscal year, the taxing authority of each subdivision shall pass an appropriation measure, and thereafter during the year it may pass any supplemental appropriation measures as it finds necessary, based on the revised tax budget or the official certificate of estimated resources or amendments of the certificate; and

WHEREAS, appropriations measures shall be classified so as to set forth separately the amounts appropriated for each office, department and division, and, within each, the amount appropriated for personal services. (RC 5705.38(C))

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council, the legislative authority of the Village of Greenwich, State of Ohio, (RC 731.18) as follows:

Section 1: To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village during fiscal year ending **December 31, 2020**, the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 2: The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance resolution of council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

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Section 3: No appropriation measure shall become effective until the county auditor files with the appropriating authority (Village) a certificate that the total appropriations from each fund, taken together with all other outstanding appropriations, do not exceed such official estimate, or amended official estimate. (RC 5705.39)

Section 4: The Clerk is hereby instructed to submit a certified copy of this Ordinance / Annual Appropriation Measure to the County Auditor.

Section 5: PUBLIC MEETING. It is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Ordinance/Resolution were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, as required by law and any applicable provisions of

Ohio Revised Code, Section 121.22.

Section 6: DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY:

That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, pursuant to RC 731.30, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

The immediate effectiveness of this ordinance is necessary to establish the village's permanent annual appropriation measure and to set aside the necessary funds in order to ensure the timely performance of Village operations and timely payment of Village current expenses and obligations for the fiscal year.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
