VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO RESOLUTION NO.: 2020-R-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 HURON COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY CONTRACTS ASSOCIATED THEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development administers Community and Economic Development Block Grant (CDBG) Programs that provide federal and state funding to communities to address a variety of needs including critical infrastructure projects designed to assist applicant communities with high-priority, single-component projects such as roads, flood and drainage and other public infrastructure improvements with a high community-wide impact; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator reports that Huron County Community Block Grant (CDBG) funds are available and could be used for the repair and improvement of South Pleasant and Gifford Streets in the village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator recommends and is seeking authorization to apply for Huron County Community Block Grant (CDBG) funding and to execute any necessary contracts associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, in those villages that have established the position of village administrator, the village administrator shall make contracts, purchase supplies and materials, and provide labor for any work under the administrator's supervision involving not more than fifty thousand dollars. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code; See also Section 232.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code]

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator be and is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit an application to participate in the fiscal year 2020 Huron County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for funding assistance for the repair and improvement of South Pleasant and Gifford Streets in the village.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is further authorized to execute any necessary contracts associated therewith.

SECTION 3. That any agreements authorized herein shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code; See also Section 232.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code]

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. [R.C. 731.17(A) (2)] That the legislative Authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

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SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT.

That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance/Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

Application is required on/before April 10th, 2020

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance/Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
