## VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO RESOLUTION NO.: 2020-R-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PARTICULAR PROPERTY WHICH IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED BY INTERNET AUCTION AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ESTABLISH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PARTICULAR SALE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 721.01 of the Ohio Revised Code provides in part that, municipal corporations have special power to sell personal property belonging to the municipal corporation, when such personal property is not needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator reports he is in possession of particular equipment which is not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator specifically reports that:

*List of equipment no longer needed by village utilities.  
All equipment has been replaced over several years.*

Galion Asphalt Roller  
1997 Chevy ¾ Ton Utility Truck  
Tennant Street Sweeper  
FMC sewer Cleaner*

WHEREAS, village council previously by resolution 2020-R-16 expressed its intent to sell property by internet auction during calendar year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is requesting authority to sell the above particular property by internet auction pursuant to RC 721.15(D).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That village council hereby finds that the following particular personal property is not needed for any municipal purpose pursuant to RC 721.01:

*2003 GMC 3500 Dump Truck  
Galion Asphalt Roller  
1997 Chevy ¾ Ton Utility Truck  
Tennant Street Sweeper  
FMC sewer Cleaner*

SECTION 2. That village council further finds that the particular personal property described herein is not needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired pursuant to RC 721, 15(D).

SECTION 3. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sell the particular personal property described herein by internet auction.

SECTION 4. MINIMUM PRICE. The Village Administrator is authorized to establish a minimum price that will be accepted for particular items.

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**SECTION 5. PARTICULAR TERMS AND CONDITIONS.** The Village Administrator may establish any other terms and conditions for the particular sale, including requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment, and sales tax subject to other terms and conditions determined by council. See RC 721.15(D) paragraph 3.

**SECTION 6. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT.** That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance/Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): ***The Administrator is requesting authority before June 20, 2020***

**SECTION 7. PUBLIC MEETING.** That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance/Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
