## VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 20<u>21</u>-R-09

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC FOR VILLAGE WASTE DISPOSAL / TRASH COLLECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 3707.43 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the legislative authority of a municipal corporation may contract for a period of not to exceed five years for the collection and removal of the garbage, night soil, dead animals, and other solid waste substances mentioned in section 3707.42 of the Revised Code at the expense of the municipal corporation or at the expense of persons responsible for the existence of such waste substances; and

WHEREAS, the current contract for Village Waste Disposal / Trash Collection and Removal will expire on May 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Village Administrator</u> was authorized to advertise and receive Bids for waste disposal/trash collection and removal services by <u>MOTION OF COUNCIL</u> passed on the <u>16<sup>th</sup></u> day of March, 20**21**; and

WHEREAS, the sealed Bids were publicly opened and read on May 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Village Administrator</u> submits that <u>RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC</u> submitted the lowest and best Bid in compliance with all bid, contract and legal requirements, and

WHEREAS, the <u>Village Administrator</u> further submits that <u>RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC</u> is a responsible bidder capable and qualified to furnish the labor, service and equipment necessary to satisfy requirements of the contract and the needs of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in those villages that have established the position of village administrator, the village administrator shall make contracts, purchase supplies and materials, and provide labor for any work under the administrator's supervision involving not more than fifty thousand dollars. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code]

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>RESOLVED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Council finds it is necessary to provide the following services:

<u>Village Waste Disposal / Trash Collection and Removal Services</u>

SECTION 2. That Council finds that the following has submitted the lowest and best Bid and is a company/business/professional qualified to furnish the labor, service and equipment necessary to satisfy the requirements of the agreement: **RUMPKE OF OHIO**, **INC** 

SECTION 3. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement consistent with the terms of the following:

A. BID ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE: *Rumpke Bid dated April 30, 2021*; and B. CONTRACT ALSO ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED

HEREIN BY REFERENCE

SECTION 4. That the contract shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code]

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SECTION 5. DURATION. That the Agreement is hereby authorized for a term of:  Three (3) years with a 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> year renewal option.
SECTION 6. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)]
SECTION 7. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance/Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):
The current Waste/Trash Contract/Agreement will expire May 31. 2021.
SECTION 8. <u>PUBLIC MEETING</u> . That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
WHEREFORE, this legislation shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
