**Administrator's Report:** Administrator Giles handed out his administrators report updating information on the changing our communications to wireless, water main breaks and water repairs. A vehicle accident on Friday (12/30/2016) took power out for about 6 hours. Plowing for snow removal will continue, Giles asked the drivers to drive cautiously and be mindful. Giles discussed more on grants, Christmas décor removal and converting to new software in the utilities department, also the revamping of the villages website.

**Police Chief's Report:** Chief Dorsey stated that he is still working on grants for the police department. Training for his officers were met in 2016 and that the state of Ohio is increasing training for officers to 24 hours, 12 of those hours are mandatory.
