VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO ORDINANCE NO: 2023-04

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM FISCAL OFFICER, ESTABLISHING DUTIES AND STARTING COMPENSATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the village of Greenwich needs a Interim Fiscal Officer due to an unexpected opening; and

WHEREAS, Section 236.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code Village combines the positions of Clerk of Council and Village Treasurer as provided by Section 733.261 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code, in lieu of having the combined elected office of village clerk-treasurer, the village combined the duties of the clerk and treasurer into one appointed office known as the <u>village fiscal officer</u>. See Section 236.015 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code which provides:

236.015 <u>CLERK-TREASURER (VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER); APPOINTMENT</u>.

- (a) The Clerk-Treasurer shall be appointed by the Mayor and appointment will become effective after approval by a majority vote of the Council.
- (b) The Clerk-Treasurer benefit and wage compensation will be paid from the following funds: water, electric, and sewer, according to the available funds and appropriation made.
- (c) The Clerk-Treasurer may be removed from the position without cause by the Mayor with consent of a majority of the Village Council or a three-fourths vote of Council without the consent of the Mayor.
- (d) The Clerk-Treasurer may or may not be a resident of the Village.

WHEREAS, the Interim Fiscal Officer shall be appointed by the mayor and appointment will become effective after approval by a majority vote of the Council. See Section 236.015(a) of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code and Section 733.262(D) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is seeking Council's approval for the appointment of **SHELLIE CHERRY** to the position of Interim Village Fiscal Officer retroactive April 11th, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF <u>GREENWICH</u> STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT. That Council hereby approves the mayor's appointment of SHELLIE CHERRY to the position of Interim Village Fiscal Officer retroactive April 11th, 2023.

SECTION 2. That the Interim Fiscal Officer shall perform the duties provided by law for the village clerk and treasurer and any other duties consistent with the nature of the office that are provided for by municipal ordinance. [See Section 733.262(C) of the Ohio Revised Code]

SECTION 3. TAX ADMINISTRATOR. That the Interim Fiscal Officer shall further perform the duties necessary for the operation of the village Tax Department pursuant to Section 236.02 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code. Accordingly, the Interim Fiscal Officer is hereby charged with direct responsibility for administration of any income tax levied by the village in accordance with this Chapter 881 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code and is designated as Tax Administrator as defined by Section 881.03(c)(44) of the Greenwich Tax Code.

SECTION 4. That the Interim Fiscal Officer shall perform other tasks and assignments not inconsistent with the position as directed from time to time by the mayor.

SECTION 5. That the Interim Fiscal Officer shall not disburse any funds except upon an order signed by at least one member of the village's legislative authority and countersigned by the village fiscal officer pursuant to Section 733.46(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That the Interim Fiscal Officer benefit and wage compensation will be paid from the following funds: water, electric, and sewer, according to the available funds and appropriation made. [See Page 1 of 3
