RESOLUTION TO PROCEED [RC 5705.03 5705.19 5705.191]

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED WITHIN THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION WILL BE INSUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE FOR THE NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SUBDIVISION AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL

SUBDIVISION AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SUBDIVISION AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THAT LIMITATION FOR **POLICE** PURPOSES AT **5.0** MILLS AS ESTIMATED BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND THAT THE TAXING AUTHORITY WILL **PROCEED** WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF THE TAX TO THE ELECTORS.

WHEREAS, the Village adopted a RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY, No.: <u>2023-R-14</u> determining that it was necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation and requesting the county auditor certify to the village certain tax valuation information; and

WHEREAS, the county auditor of **Huron** County, Ohio has certified the following:

- 1. On <u>July 14, 2023</u> the taxing authority of the <u>Village of Greenwich</u> certified a copy of its resolution adopted <u>July 11, 2023</u>, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by <u>five</u> (5.0) mills, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for <u>police</u> purposes pursuant to Revised Code Section <u>5705.19(J)</u>, to be placed on the ballot at the <u>November 7, 2023</u> election. The type is <u>additional</u>.
- 2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 100,995.00
- 3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$20,199,020.

WHEREAS, Section 5705.03(B)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that upon receiving the certification from the county auditor, the taxing authority may adopt a resolution or ordinance stating the rate of the tax levy, expressed in mills for each one dollar in tax valuation as estimated by the county auditor, and that the taxing authority will proceed with the submission of the question of the tax to electors. The taxing authority shall certify this resolution or ordinance, a copy of the county auditor's certification, and the resolution or ordinance the taxing authority adopted under division (B)(1) of this section to the proper county board of elections in the manner and within the time prescribed by the section of the Revised Code governing submission of the question; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the taxing authority of any subdivision, by a vote of two-thirds of all its members, may declare by resolution that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the subdivision, and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation for any of the purposes in section 5705.19 of the Revised Code, and that the question of such additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the subdivision at a general, primary, or special election to be held at a time therein specified; and

WHEREAS, the funds generated by this levy has been historically and exclusively used by

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>RESOLVED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO, (RC 731.18) <u>TWO-THIRDS</u> OF ALL MEMBERS CONCURRING [RC 5705.191]:

SECTION 1. That Village Council hereby states that it will proceed with the submission of the question of the tax to electors. RC 5705.03(B)(3)

SECTION 2. That Village Council, by a vote of two-thirds of all its members, hereby declares that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village, and that it is necessary to levy an <u>additional</u> tax in excess of such limitation for <u>police purposes</u>, and that the question of such additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village at the election to be held <u>November 7, 2023</u>. RC 5705.191

SECTION 3. That Village Council, as required by Section 5705.03(B)(1)(a)-(i) of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby states all of the following:
