ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND
ORC 5705.09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL **POLICE LEVY FUND** PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.09(D) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR THE DEPOSIT OF REVENUE GENERATED BY THE POLICE LEVY AND THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS THEREFROM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 5705.09(J) of the Ohio Revised Code that each subdivision shall establish a special fund for each special levy and reads as follows:

Section 5705.09 | Establishment of funds.

Each subdivision shall establish the following funds:

- (A) General fund;*
- (B) Sinking fund whenever the subdivision has outstanding bonds other than serial bonds;*
- (C) Bond retirement fund, for the retirement of serial bonds, notes, or certificates of indebtedness;*
- (D) A special fund for each special levy;***
- (E) A special bond fund for each bond issue;*
- (F) A special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose;*
- (G) A special fund for each public utility operated by a subdivision;*
- (H) A trust fund for any amount received by a subdivision in trust.*

WHEREAS, voters in the Village recently approved a levy for **POLICE PURPOSES** pursuant to ORC 5705.19(J); and

WHEREAS, the Village is now required to establish a fund to deposit the revenue generated by the levy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to take all steps necessary to create a special revenue fund pursuant to ORC 5705.09(D) as follows:

Fund 2903 – Police Levy Fund
Revenue Account No.: 2903-110-0000

SECTION 2. That the purpose of the fund shall be to receive and deposit revenue generated by the POLICE LEVY established pursuant to ORC 5705.19(J) and for the appropriation of funds therefrom.

SECTION 3. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. R.C. 731.17(A)(2) That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

SECTION 4. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

The Fiscal Officer reports that the Village is already in receipt of the Estimated Revenue Certificate from the Huron County Auditor.

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SECTION 5. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
