VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO FILE A PETITION TO RECEIVE PROPERTY THROUGH FORFEITURE PURSUANT TO SECTION 5723.01 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Village is in receipt of JUDGMENT ENTRY OF NOTIFICATION AND OFFER PURSUANT TO R.C. 5723.01(A)(3) from the Court of Common Pleas of Huron County, Ohio, Case No.: 2023-0338; and

WHEREAS certain property is now offered to the Village upon a petition filed with the Court within ten (10) days; and

WHEREAS the Village Administrator has identified a potential public purpose for the property; and

WHEREAS the Village Administrator recommends that Village Council authorize the Village Solicitor to file a PETITION TO RECEIVE PROPERTY THROUGH FORFEITURE for certain property; and

WHEREAS Village Council acknowledges that if the Petition is granted, then the Village shall be required to make payment for the costs of delinquent taxes and costs due on the property, along with transfer fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>RESOLVED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That the Village Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to file a PETITION TO RECEIVE PROPERTY THROUGH FORFEITURE in the Court of Common Pleas, Case No.: 2023-0338 to receive the following parcel(s):

PPN 16-041C-02-093-0000 [ONLY] (Also known as 49 North Kniffin Street)

The village wishes to decline the remaining parcels listed in CVE 2023-0339

SECTION 2. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

SECTION 4. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
