FINAL APPOINTMENT OF POLICE OFFICER

A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH MAYOR'S FINAL APPOINTMENT OF <u>ALEXANDER</u> <u>J. MICHEL</u> TO GREENWICH POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 737.16 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the appointment of village deputy marshals and police officers as follows:

Section 737.16 | Appointment of deputy marshals, police officers, night guards and special police officers.

The mayor shall, when provided for by the legislative authority of a village, and subject to its confirmation, appoint all deputy marshals, police officers, night guards, and special police officers. All such officers shall continue in office until removed therefrom for the cause and in the manner provided by section 737.19 of the Revised Code.

WHEREAS, Section 737.17 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the probationary period and final appointment of village deputy marshals, also known as police officers, as follows:

Section 737.17 | Probationary period - final appointment.

All appointments made under sections 737.15 and 737.16 of the Revised Code shall be for a probationary period of six months' continuous service, and none shall be finally made until the appointee has satisfactorily served his probationary period. At the end of the probationary period the mayor shall transmit to the legislative authority of the village a record of such employee's service with his recommendations thereon and he may, with the concurrence of the legislative authority, remove or finally appoint the employee.

WHEREAS, Section 242.07(b) of the Greenwich Municipal Code <u>CURRENTLY</u> requires that all Village patrolmen whether full or part time, shall serve a <u>one-year</u> continuous service probationary period and none shall be finally hired until the appointee has satisfactorily served the probationary period; and

WHEREAS, Officer <u>ALEXANDER J. MICHEL</u> obtained Confirmation of Mayor's Probationary Appointment to the police department in Resolution No.: <u>2022-R-24</u> (part-time) and <u>2023-R-12</u> (full-time); and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police reports that the probationary patrolman has satisfactorily served the probationary period and is requesting that the mayor seek concurrence of council for final appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has transmitted to Council a record of such probationary patrolman's service; as required by Section 737.17 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the record and at the recommendation of the Chief of Police, the Mayor recommends that the probationary patrolman receive the concurrence of council for final appointment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC~731.18)

SECTION 1. CONCURRENCE WITH FINAL APPOINTMENT. That after a review of the record of the probationary patrolman, Council hereby concurs with the mayor's final appointment of **ALEXANDER J. MICHEL** to the Greenwich Police Department effective the 6th day of **December**, 2023.

SECTION 2. That upon concurrence of council for final appointment, this officer shall continue in office until removed therefrom for cause and in a manner provided by Section 737.19 of the Revised Code. [See also RC 737.16]
