A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY PPN: 16-041C-02-093-0000 IN THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH WHICH WAS ORDERED TO BE FORFEITED TO THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH BY THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF HURON COUNTY AND DIRECTING FISCAL OFFICER TO COMPLY WITH COURT ORDER AND MAKE PAYMENT FOR THE COSTS OF DELINQUENT TAXES ACCRUED BY THE FORMER OWNER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on <u>May 19, 2023</u>, the Huron County Treasurer filed a Complaint for Real Estate Tax Lien Foreclosure in the Court of Common Pleas of Huron County, Case No.: CVE 2023-0338, regarding certain subject property located in the Village of Greenwich, Ohio (PPN: 16-041C-02-093-0000); and

WHEREAS, the Court issued Judgment Entry of Notification and Offer Pursuant to R.C. 5723.01(A)(3) providing the Village of Greenwich notice that the subject property has twice been offered for sale and not sold for want of a bidder, and is now offered to be forfeited to the Village of Greenwich filed 12/26/2023 and journalized 1-2-24. VOL 844, PG 910 and received by the Village on 1-4-24; and

WHEREAS, the Village adopted Res No.: <u>2024-R-03</u> adopted the 16 day of January, 20<u>24</u>, authorizing the Solicitor to file a Petition to Receive Property Through Forfeiture (PPN: 16-041C-02-093-0000 ONLY); and

WHEREAS, with proper leave of the Court, the Village filed its Petition to Receive Property Through Forfeiture pursuant to R.C. 5723.01(A)(3) on <u>January 17, 2024</u>; and

WHEREAS, On <u>January 30, 2024</u> the Court issued and journalized VOL <u>845</u> PG <u>994</u> an Order to Forfeit Property to the Village of Greenwich and further Ordered that the Court certify a copy of the Entry to the Huron County Auditor and all right, title, claim and interest of the former owner is transferred to the Village of Greenwich upon the receipt of payment for the costs of delinquent taxes, court costs accrued hereon, and costs due on the property along with transfer fees, in the amount of <u>Three Hundred Ninety-Eight</u> Dollars and <u>28/100</u> (\$398.28) pursuant to section 5723.01(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO:  $(RC\ 731.18)$ 

SECTION 1. That Council hereby accepts the transfer of the subject property ordered forfeited by Order of the Court of Common Pleas of Huron County in Case No.: CVE 2023-0338, journalized <u>January 30, 2024 VOL 845 PG 994</u> and located in Greenwich, OH (PPN: 16-041C-02-093-0000)

SECTION 2. That the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to make payment for the costs of delinquent taxes and costs due on the property, along with transfer fees in the amount of Three Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and 28/100 (\$398.28) pursuant to section 5723.01(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code.
