RESCINDING AND REPEALING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE RC 5705.38

AN ORDINANCE <u>RESCINDING AND REPEALING</u> AN ORDINANCE [ORD NO.: 2024-O-08] MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING 12/31/2024 AND AMENDING THE 2024 PERMANENT APPROPRIATION MEASURE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Village Council previously passed Ordinance No.: 20<u>23</u>-O-<u>19</u> titled PERMANENT APPROPRIATION MEASURE setting the annual appropriations for the year and providing for the current expenses and other expenditures of the village; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer specifically reports that:

Council previously passed <u>Ord No.: 2024-O-08</u> SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE for receipt of unanticipated funds in form of donations from businesses for "Park" sponsorship banner and concert in the parks.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer further reports that:

After the passage of Supplemental Ord No.: 2024-O-08 the Village received another donation for banners and parks. The additional donation was received before Supplemental Ord 2024-O-08 was submitted to the County Auditor for an amended certificate.

The Fiscal Officer further reports that she requested, and council passed, a second Supplemental Ordinance No.: <u>2024-0-09</u> which supplemented the appropriations for all the park and banner donations including those contained in Ord 2024-0-08.

Finally, the Fiscal Officer reports that Supplemental Ordinance 2024-O-08 was not submitted to the County Auditor, however, Supplemental Ordinance 2024-O-09 has been submitted to the County Auditor and the Village has received an amended certificate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT $\underline{\text{ORDAINED}}$ BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Council finds that Supplemental Ordinance No.: 2024-O-08 has not yet been submitted to the County Auditor based on the representation of the Fiscal Officer.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That Council finds that the Village has not been provided with an amended certificate based upon Supplemental Ordinance No.: 2024-O-08 based on the representation of the Fiscal Officer.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That Council finds that Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance 2024-O-09 accurately represents the total unanticipated funds received for "banners and parks" and includes those referenced in 2024-O-08 based on the representation of the Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 4. That Council finds that (even though adopted prior to Ord 2024-O-09) is duplicative and no longer necessary.

SECTION 5. RESCIND AND REPEAL. That Council hereby RESCINDS AND REPEALS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE ORDINANCE NO.: 2024-O-08.
