VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO ORDINANCE NO.: 2024-0-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION <u>242.02</u> OF THE GREENWICH CODIFIED MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING RESIDENCY RADIUS OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, to provide an increase in future potential candidates for the position of Chief of Police, Village council desires to amend the residency requirement radius; and

WHEREAS, the village recently hired a Chief of Police who lives outside the current residency radius requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. AMEND. That Section <u>242.02</u> of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

242.02 RESIDENCY OF CHIEF OF POLICE.

Any law or ordinance that requires the Village Marshal or Chief of Police to live within the Village is hereby waived. However, if the Chief does reside outside the Village, he or she must reside within three twenty-five (25) miles of the Village. The Chief of Police must comply with this section no later than six months upon the completion of the probationary period and final appointment or the Chief shall be disqualified from office and forfeit the position. SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS. That any amendments herein are indicated with additions appearing in **bold and underline** and deletions appearing in **bold and strikethrough**.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>CODIFICATION</u>. That the Council Clerk is hereby directed to submit the amendments herein to the codification service for the Village.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
