VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GREENWICH, OHIO ORDINANCE NO.: 2024-0-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION <u>242.03</u> OF THE GREENWICH CODIFIED MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING PROTECTION FOR PROPERTY OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, Section 715.50 of the Ohio Revised Code provides as follows:

Section 715.50 | Police or sanitary regulations for property outside municipal corporation limits. A municipal corporation owning and using lands beyond its limits for a municipal purpose may provide, by ordinance or resolution, all needful police or sanitary regulations for the protection of such property and may prosecute violations thereof in the municipal court of such municipal corporation.

WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor has requested that the Village Council amend and update Section <u>242.03</u> of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. AMEND. That Section 242.03 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

242.03 **PROTECTION POLICE OR SANITARY REGULATIONS** FOR PROPERTY OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE.

Pursuant to Ohio R.C. 715.50, the Village shall provide all needful police regulations for the protection of property outside the corporate limits of the Village.

When the Village owns and uses lands beyond its limits for a municipal purpose, the Village may provide all needful police or sanitary regulations for the protection of such property and may prosecute violations thereof in the municipal court of such municipal corporation to the extent permitted by Section. 715.50 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> CODIFICATION. That the Council Clerk is hereby directed to submit the amendments herein to the codification service for the Village.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
