COMPENSATION RC 731.13

AN ORDINANCE <u>AMENDING ORD 2016-03 AND</u> FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF <u>VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR</u> AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 731.13 of the Ohio Revised Code requires in part:

Section 731.13 | Compensation and bonds of village officers, clerks and employees.

The legislative authority of a village shall fix the compensation and bonds of all officers, clerks, and employees of the village except as otherwise provided by law.

WHEREAS, to maintain the efficient fiscal operations, Village Council deems it necessary to adjust the fixed compensation of officers, clerks, and employees from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Section 232.03 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of ordinances provides compensation of Administrator as follows:

232.03 COMPENSATION

(a) For the discharge of the duties set forth in Section 232.02, the Administrator shall receive a salary as determined from time to time by Council. Such sum shall be charged to the following funds as well as those salaries of the employees which the Administrator appropriations made.

(b) In addition to the salary provided for in division (a) hereof, the Administrator shall be entitled to a sum, to be determined from time to time by Council, for the acquisition and maintenance of a Class 1 Ohio Water License, passing any and all necessary examinations for the acquisition of the same. An additional sum, to be determined by Council, shall be paid for the acquisition and maintenance of a Class 1 Ohio Waste Water License. (Ord. 708. Passed 11-16-82.)

WHEREAS, Village Council previously fixed the compensation of the Village Administrator in Ord. No(s).: $\underline{2016}$ - $\underline{03}$ and $\underline{2021}$ - $\underline{07}$; and

WHEREAS, the Village recently hired a new Village Administrator who will also serve as Operator of Record for both water and wastewater.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT $\underline{ORDAINED}$ BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF $\underline{GREENWICH}$, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1</u>. <u>FIXING COMPENSATION</u>. That Village Council hereby fixes and <u>amends</u> the compensation of <u>VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR</u> as follows:

Section 1: COMPENSATION OF THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

The range of annual compensation of the Village Administrator shall be and is hereby established between a minimum of \$39,520.00 and a maximum of \$74,880.00 payable according to the regular pay cycle of the Village.

\$70,000.00 base annual salary plus overtime.

Base annual salary shall include Operator of Record, Village Administrator and the Zoning Administrator.

- A. The base wage, miscellaneous pay and other benefits for the Village Administrator under this section shall be paid from the following funds: General (Zoning), Street, Water, Sewer and Electric.
- B. Employee will contribute 3.5% to Health Care Cost.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. That this Ordinance hereby repeals, rescinds, and replaces any and all previous Compensation Ordinances inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 3. EFFECT. That this Ordinance shall take effect as of the first regular pay period beginning RETROACTIVELY on 08/26/2024

SECTION 4. RETROACTIVE. That Council expressly intends the amendments adopted herein to operate retrospectively pursuant to Section 1.48 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Council further finds that the retroactive application does not takes away or impair vested rights acquired under current existing laws, nor does it create new obligations, nor imposes a new duty, nor attaches a new disability, in respect to transactions or considerations already passed and adopted.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. That this Ordinance and the various parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. Should any part, sentence, paragraph, section, or clause be declared unconstitutional, null, or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining parts, sentences, paragraphs, sections, and clauses of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 6. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

To be in effect retroactively on 08/26/2024

SECTION 7. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
