TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION MEASURE 2025 RC 5705 18

AN ORDINANCE POSTPONING THE **2025** ANNUAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE AND PROVIDING FOR <u>TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS</u> FOR MEETING ORDINARY EXPENSES AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 5705.38 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38(A) provides that on or about the first day of each fiscal year, the taxing authority of each subdivision shall pass an appropriation measure, and thereafter during the year it may pass any supplemental appropriation measures as it finds necessary, based on the revised tax budget or the official certificate of estimated resources or amendments of the certificate; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38(A) further provides that if the taxing authority of each subdivision desires to postpone the passage of the annual appropriation measure until an amended certificate is received based on the actual balances, it may pass a temporary appropriation measure for meeting the ordinary expenses of the taxing unit until no later than the first day of April; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38(C) further provides that appropriation measures shall be classified so as to set forth separately the amounts appropriated for each office, department, and division, and, within each, the amount appropriated for personal services; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer recommends that the village postpone the passage of the annual appropriation measure until an amended certificate is received based on the actual balances; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer further recommends that the village pass a temporary appropriation measure for meeting the ordinary expenses of the taxing unit until no later than the first day of April 20<u>25</u>.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF <u>GREENWICH</u>, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

- SECTION 1: That the passage of the annual appropriation measure is hereby postponed until an amended certificate is received based on the actual balances.
- SECTION 2: That the Village hereby adopts and passes a temporary appropriation measure for meeting the ordinary expenses of the village until no later than the first day of April 2025, ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE.
- SECTION 3: That such amounts temporarily appropriated herein shall be chargeable to the annual appropriation ordinance to be enacted before the first day of April 2025.
- SECTION 4: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the Council authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution for Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance
