APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR ORC 735.271

A RESOLUTION APPROVING <u>MICHAEL D. STEVENS</u> AS THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the former village administrator recently tendered his resignation effective July 19, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code reads in part that:

The village administrator shall be appointed by the mayor, but shall not take office unless his appointment has been approved by a majority vote of the members elected to the legislative authority of the village.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has selected his potential appointee to serve as village administrator and now seeks the approval of council.

WHEREAS, additionally, the Mayor would like to thank the temporary interim village administrator for his work during the transition period and seeks council approval for the termination of the temporary interim appointment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18):

<u>SECTION 1</u>. <u>APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT</u>. That Village Council hereby approves <u>by a majority vote of the members elected</u>; the mayor's appointment of village administrator as follows:

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE. That this appointment shall be effective on August 26, 2024.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>TERMINATION OF TEMPORARY INTERIM APPOINTMENT</u>. Village Council hereby thanks the temporary interim village administrator for his work during the transition period and approves the mayor's termination of the temporary interim appointment.

SECTION 4. CENTRAL PURCHASING AGENT. That pursuant to ORC 731.141 and Section 232.09 of the Village of Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances, the Village Administrator appointed herein is further designated as Central Purchasing Agent for central purchasing for all offices, departments, divisions, boards, and commissions of the village, who shall make contracts, purchase supplies or materials, and provide labor for any work of the village.

SECTION 5. COMPENSATION. That the village administrator shall be compensated as fixed by council pursuant to Section 731.13 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 232.03 of the Village of Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances.
