A RESOLUTION CONSIDERING IT NECESSARY TO PROVIDE LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE VILLAGE, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LEGAL COUNSEL, AND PROVIDING COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 733.48(A) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that, when it considers it necessary, the legislative authority of a village may provide legal counsel for the village and shall provide compensation.

WHEREAS, Section 234.01 of the Greenwich Codified Code of Municipal Ordinances requires that legal counsel shall be provided for the Village; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>RESOLVED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

- SECTION 1. LEGAL COUNSEL. That Council considers it necessary to provide legal counsel for the village pursuant to Section 733.48(A) of the Ohio Revised Code. (See also Greenwich Code Section 234.01)
- SECTION 2. COMPENSATION. In addition to regular compensation (Retainer) as provided by Compensation Ordinance (See ORC 731.13 and *Greenwich Code 234.03*) the Solicitor shall be paid additional compensation as provided by the Agreement authorized herein.
- SECTION 3. AGREEMENT. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with legal counsel and providing for compensation and other terms of engagement. See Agreement ATTACHED HERETO and incorporated herein by reference. (See ORC 733.48(A) and ORC 731.13[Compensation])
- <u>SECTION 4. APPOINTMENT.</u> That Village Council hereby appoints attorney <u>STEVE PALMER</u> as legal counsel, Village Solicitor, and Municipal Prosecutor.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. That all previous legal counsel legislation and agreements inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded and repealed.
- SECTION 6. <u>DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS</u>. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)]
- SECTION 7. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the
