#### **ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND**

ORC 5705.09 New General Fund Line Items

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW ADDITIONAL LINE ITEMS WITHIN THE <u>GENERAL</u> FUND FOR CONTINGENCIES AND POLICE GRANTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 5705.09(J) of the Ohio Revised Code states that each subdivision shall establish certain funds and reads as follows:

Section 5705.09 | Establishment of funds.

Each subdivision shall establish the following funds:

- (A) General fund;
- (B) Sinking fund whenever the subdivision has outstanding bonds other than serial bonds;
- (C) Bond retirement fund, for the retirement of serial bonds, notes, or certificates of indebtedness;
- (D) A special fund for each special levy;
- (E) A special bond fund for each bond issue;
- (F) A special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose;
- (G) A special fund for each public utility operated by a subdivision;
- (H) A trust fund for any amount received by a subdivision in trust.

WHEREAS, as required by ORC 5705.09(A) the Village has established and maintains a General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has requested Village Council add new additional line items to the <u>General</u> Fund for contingencies and for police grants; and

WHEREAS, ORC 5705.40, second paragraph, permits the appropriation for contingencies which reads in part:

<u>Section 5705.40 Amending or supplementing appropriation ordinance - transfer - unencumbered balance - appropriation for contingencies.</u>

The annual appropriation measure, or an amendment or supplement thereto, may contain an appropriation for <u>contingencies</u> not to exceed the amount authorized by section 5705.29 of the Revised Code.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to accept the recommendation of the Fiscal Officer and create additional line items in the <u>General</u> Fund for contingencies and police grants.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1.</u> <u>NEW LINE ITEM(S)</u>. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to add new line item(s) as follows:
