AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE MEETINGS OF VILLAGE COUNCIL AND AMENDING GREENWICH CODIFIED CODE SECTION 220.01 ESTABLISHING REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS BY ORDINANCE AS PROVIDED BY ORC 731.46.

WHEREAS, President of Council Beverly would like to amend the regular meetings of council as follows:

*"I would like to create an ordinance that states on all election days, because they always fall on first Tuesday of the month, be changed to first Wednesday of the month.
I would like to have only the Council meetings that fall on election day changed to the following day, Wednesday. The first Wednesday of the month."*

WHEREAS, Section 731.46 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the meetings may be held at such time and place as is prescribed by ordinance and reads as follows: [See also Greenwich Council Rules]

*Section 731.46 | Meetings of legislative authority.
The legislative authority of a municipal corporation shall not be required to hold more than one regular meeting in each week. The meetings may be held at such time and place as is prescribed by ordinance and shall, at all times, be open to the public. The mayor, or any three members of the legislative authority may call special meetings upon at least twelve hours' notice to each member, served personally or left at his usual place of residence.*

WHEREAS, Section 220.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances also provides for regular council meetings and currently reads:

*220.01 MEETINGS.
Regular Council meetings will be held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at a time determined by Council at the annual organizational meeting.
(Res. 98-2. Passed 1-20-98; Ord. 926. Passed 9-12-00; Ord. 2010-11. Passed 12-21-10.)*

WHEREAS, the time and place for council meetings was previously prescribed in Ord No.: 2002-O-04, 2021-O-04, and 2023-O-01, and **2024-O-11**. The Time and place for council meetings is also noted within the Rules of Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1: MEETINGS OF COUNCIL. That Village Council hereby prescribes that REGULAR SESSIONS of council meetings shall be held at the following time and place:

TIME: First and Third Tuesday of each month promptly at 6:00 o'clock PM.
PLACE: Village Hall, located at 45 Main Street, Greenwich, Ohio 44837.

On any first Tuesday conflicting with an election day, the regular meeting shall instead be held on the first Wednesday of the month.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. That Section 220.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

220.01 MEETINGS.

Regular Council meetings ~~will be held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at a time determined by Council at the annual organizational meeting~~ may be held at such time and place as is prescribed by ordinance and shall, at all times, be open to the public as provided by ORC 731.46.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TEXT. That any amendments herein are indicated with additions appearing in **bold and underline** and deletions appearing in **bold and strikethrough**.

SECTION 4. CODIFICATION. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby instructed and directed to submit the amendments contained herein to the codification and publication service for the Village.

SECTION 5: That any ordinance or rule inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed, rescinded, and replaced.

SECTION 6. That the mayor, or any three members of the legislative authority may call special meetings upon at least twelve hours' notice to each member, served personally or left at his usual place of residence. (See ORC 731.46)

SECTION 7. RULES OF COUNCIL. That the FISCAL OFFICER is hereby instructed and directed to implement any necessary updates to the Rules of Council that may be affected by the changes herein

SECTION 8. EFFECT. That this legislation shall take effect: 2025 Election

SECTION 8. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution / Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
