AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO ORC SECTION 721.15(A) AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PER-SONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR VILLAGE PURPOSES WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS OR MORE
