LEASE-PURCHASE Police Cruiser

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUOTE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH STATEWIDE MUNICIPAL LEASING OF VAN WERT OHIO, FOR THE LEASE PURCHASE OF A POLICE CRUISER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police reports that the Police Department is in need of an additional Police Cruiser; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Fiscal Officer report that the Village is not in a fiscal position to outright purchase a police cruiser; and

WHEREAS, with current budget constraints in mind, the Chief of Police has secured a Quote for the Lease-Purchase of a police cruiser submitted by STATEWIDE MUNICIPAL LEASING of Van Wert, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Quote for Lease Purchase arrangement appears to comply with Ohio Auditor of State Bulletin 2024-002 [See Ohio Auditor Bulletin 2024-002, Pg 2, Footnote 1); and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has submitted this issue to the Police Committee of Village Council, and they recommend the acceptance of the Quote and the authorization for Village Administrator as Central Purchasing Agent to enter into the Lease-Purchase arrangement; and

WHEREAS, the Village has designated the Village Administrator as Central Purchasing Agent for all offices and departments. [See Section 232.09 of the Village of Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances].

232.09 CENTRAL PURCHASING AGENT.

(a) Village Council hereby provides for central purchasing for all offices, departments, divisions, boards, and commissions of the Village, under the direction of the Village Administrator, who shall make contracts, purchase supplies or materials, and provide labor for any work of the Village in the manner provided by R.C. § 731.141.

(b) The Fiscal Officer shall assist the Village Administrator in the Administrator's duties as Central Purchasing Agent. (Ord. 708. Passed 11-16-82; Ord. 2024-O-19. Passed 7-16-24.)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. ACCEPT QUOTE. That Village Council hereby accepts the Quote submitted by Statewide Municipal Leasing dated 02/18/2025 for the Lease-Purchase of a Police Cruiser.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION. That the Village Administrator be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter a LEASE PURCHASE Agreement with STATEWIDE MUNICIPAL LEASING OF VAN WERT OHIO in an amount not to exceed \$68,422.00 over a four-year period consistent with the terms of the Quote Cash flow Data and the Amortization Schedule dated 2/18/2025. (SEE QUOTE ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE)

SECTION 3. VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR. That any agreements authorized herein shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code; See also Section 232.01 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code]

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least

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three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [R.C. 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

The Chief of Police reports that the Police Department is down to one operational cruiser. Three cruisers are currently out of service for repairs. One of the out-of-service cruisers requires a new engine. Currently all service miles are placed on only one operational cruiser.

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
