AUTHORIZATION Solid Waste Collection and Removal of Garbage ORC 3707.43

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL OF GARBAGE AND EXTENDING THE CURRENT CONTRACT BY ADDENDUM FOR ONE YEAR

WHEREAS, Section 3707.43 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the legislative authority of a municipal corporation may contract for a period of not to exceed five years for the collection and removal of the garbage, night soil, dead animals, and other solid waste substances mentioned in section 3707.42 of the Revised Code at the expense of the municipal corporation or at the expense of persons responsible for the existence of such waste substances; and

WHEREAS, the Village currently contracts with RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC for Solid Waste Collection and Removal of Garbage authorized most recently by Resolutions No 2021-R-09; and

WHEREAS, the current written agreement for Village Waste Collection and Removal of Garbage is set to expire on May 31, 2025 unless renewed for an additional option period upon mutual agreement of both parties; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is in receipt of a proposed ADDENDUM to May 19, 2021 Agreement inviting the Village to renew its contract for one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is seeking authorization to exercise its option and renew the current written contract by Addendum; and

WHEREAS, in those villages that have established the position of village administrator, the village administrator shall make contracts, purchase supplies and materials, and provide labor for any work under the administrator's supervision involving not more than fifty thousand dollars. [ORC 731.141 and Greenwich Code Section 232.01]; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is designated as the Central Purchasing Agent for all Village offices and departments. [See ORC 731.141 and Greenwich Code Section 232.09]

232.09 CENTRAL PURCHASING AGENT.

(a) Village Council hereby provides for central purchasing for all offices, departments, divisions, boards, and commissions of the Village, under the direction of the Village Administrator, who shall make contracts, purchase supplies or materials, and provide labor for any work of the Village in the manner provided by R.C. § 731.141.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator reports that he has complied with any Village Purchase Policy and any applicable statutory bidding requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (ORC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Council finds it is necessary to continue to provide the following services:

Solid Waste Collection and Removal of Garbage

SECTION 2. ACCEPT PROPOSAL. That Council finds that the following has submitted the lowest and best proposal and is a company/business/professional qualified to furnish the labor, service and equipment necessary to satisfy the requirements of the agreement:

RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement (**ADDENDUM**) consistent with the following terms:

ADDENDUM date 3/11/2025

(ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE)

SECTION 4. EXECUTION. That the contract shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [ORC 731.141 and Section(s) 232.01 and 232.09 of the Greenwich Code]

SECTION 5. DURATION. That the Agreement (**Addendum**) is hereby authorized for a term of:

One (1) year effective June 1, 2025, and continuing through May 3, 2026

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


