DISPOSITION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

ORC 721.15

NOT NEEDED – NO VALUE – DISCARD

ORC 721.15(C)

A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND THAT THE PROPERTY HAS NO VALUE, AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO DISCARD OR SALVAGE THAT PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator reports that he has identified certain personal property that is not needed for public use and that the property has no value; and

WHEREAS, ORC 721.15(C) provides that personal property not needed for public use with no value may be discarded and reads:

Section 721.15 | Disposition of property unneeded, obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes.

(C) If the legislative authority of the municipal corporation determines that municipal personal property is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and that the property has no value, the legislative authority may discard or salvage that property.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator is requesting that the Village Council authorize that the certain personal property described herein be discarded.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (ORC 731.18)

SECTION 1. NOT NEEDED. That Village Council hereby finds that the personal property described herein is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

SECTION 2. NO VALUE. That Village Council hereby further finds that the personal property described herein has no value.

SECTION 3. DISCARD OR SALVAGE. That Village Council hereby instructs and directs the Village Administrator to discard or salvage the following personal property as permitted by ORC 721.15(C):

SECTION 4. INVENTORY MANAGEMENT. That the Fiscal officer is hereby directed to update the village Inventory Management to reflect that the personal property described herein has been discarded or salvaged.

SECTION 5. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [ORC 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 6. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to ORC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

The Village Administrator reports that:

"We need to get this moved and disposed so we can tear down and complete projects by our deadline in October. We do not have storage room for all the building contents and need to throw away."


SECTION 7. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
