RESOLUTION OF AUTHORIZATION UTILITY RATE STUDY Cost of Service

A RESOLUTION FINDING IT NECESSARY TO OBTAIN A UTILITY RATE STUDY, AND ACCEPTING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROPOSAL OF <u>OHM ADVISORS</u> FOR VILLAGE UTILITY RATE STUDY, AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE A WRITTEN CONTRACT

WHEREAS, Public utilities operated by local governments provide communities with reliable, responsive, not-for-profit services; and

WHEREAS, throughout Ohio, municipalities have utilized professional consultants to recommend rate designs based on their independent analysis of the utilities' actual expenses and revenue requirements. The municipality provides the current and historic data for this analysis and future rate projections including State of Ohio Audit reports. The resulting report, known as a "Cost of Service" study, is submitted to the municipality for their review and consideration.

WHEREAS, "Cost of Service" is a method to equitably allocate the revenue requirements of the utility among the various customer classes of service. Two main objectives of a cost-of-service study are to 1) Ensure rates recover costs to provide service to customers (Revenue Requirements) and 2) Define optimal rate structure. Cost of service studies are suggested to be performed every 3-5 years or when there is a significant change in operations or capital improvement.

WHEREAS, the Village is considering a cost of service / utility rate study for a comprehensive financial review of the water and sewer utilities; and

WHEREAS, specifically the village is seeking professional analysis and recommendations to determine the adequacy of the existing utility rates and to provide the basis for adjustments to maintain cost-based rates for each of the utilities. Adequate rates ensure that revenues are sufficient to ensure the financial health of the utilities and to address rising personnel, operation and maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously received professional services proposal(s) for a utility rates study submitted by OHM Advisors # 24115 dated August 9, 2024, for \$11,400 then revised on 2/19/25 for \$9,400 and dated February 21, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the OHM Advisors proposal #24115 for professional services proposal(s) for a utility rates study dated August 9, 2024 for \$11,400 was submitted to Village Council in Resolution No.: 2024-R-17 and tabled on August 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Council President Pro Tempore Beverly now wishes to submit the OHM Advisors proposal #24115 for professional services proposal(s) for a utility rates study revised on 2/19/25 for \$9,400 and dated February 21, 2025 for consideration by Village Council.
