#### RESOLUTION OF AUTHORIZATION

#### RESERVOIR LAKE PARK

Greenwich Code Chapter 1066 ORC Chapter 755

## COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER

ORC 715.21 and 755.12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH RESERVOIR LAKE PARK; WHICH SHALL BE DONATED AND DEDICATED TO THE MUNICIPALITY UPON COMPLETION; AND ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OR CONDITIONS OF SUCH GIFT/DONATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenwich is a statutory municipal corporation organized pursuant to Title 7 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, ORC Section 719.01(B) permits the appropriation of property by a municipality for <u>parks</u> and reads in part:

ORC 719.01 <u>Appropriation of property by municipal corporations.</u>

Any municipal corporation may appropriate, enter upon, and hold real estate within its corporate limits:

(B) For parks, park entrances, boulevards, market places, and children's playgrounds;...

WHEREAS, ORC Section 715.21 provides municipalities the power to hold and improve public grounds for parks and <u>RECREATION CENTERS</u> and reads:

ORC Section 715.21 | <u>Power to acquire, hold, lease, sell, or donate lands.</u>
Any municipal corporation may hold, improve, protect, and preserve public grounds, parks, park entrances, free <u>recreation centers</u>, and boulevards.

Such municipal corporation may acquire by purchase, lease, with privilege of purchase, gift, devise, condemnation, or otherwise, and hold, real estate or any interest therein and other property for the use of the municipal corporation and may sell, lease, or donate by deed, in fee simple to the state, such property as a site for the erection of an armory.

WHEREAS, ORC 755.12 permits a municipal legislative authority to maintain and operate recreation facilities which includes <u>INDOOR RECREATION CENTERS</u> and reads in part:

ORC Section 755.12 | <u>Municipal corporations... may maintain and operate recreation facilities</u>.

The <u>legislative authority</u> of a municipal corporation, ... may designate and set apart for use as parks, playgrounds, playfields, gymnasiums, public baths, swimming pools, or <u>indoor recreation centers</u>, any lands or buildings owned by any such municipal corporation... and not dedicated or devoted to other public use. Such municipal corporation... may, in the manner provided by law for the acquisition of land or buildings for public purposes in such municipal corporations... acquire lands or buildings therein for such use.

WHEREAS, ORC 755.13(A) provides that the authority to supervise and maintain parks and recreation centers may be vested as the <u>LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY</u> determines and reads in part:

ORC Section 755.13 | <u>Supervision and maintenance of recreation facilities</u>.

(A) The authority to supervise and maintain parks, playgrounds, playfields, gymnasiums, public baths, swimming pools, or indoor recreation centers, may be vested in any existing body or board, or in a recreation board, as the <u>legislative authority</u> of the municipal corporation, ... determines. The local authorities of any such municipal corporation, ... may equip, develop, operate, and maintain such facilities as authorized by sections 755.12 to 755.18 of the Revised Code...

(NOTE: Greenwich Chapter 280 Park Board was repealed by Ordinance No. 2022-06, passed July 5, 2022.)

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenwich owns and operates a Municipal Park known as RESERVOIR LAKE PARK;

WHEREAS, the Village exercises regulation over Reservoir Lake Park in Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances, Chapter 1066; and

WHEREAS, in early June of 2024, the Mayor reported that an individual desired to build a Community (Indoor Recreation) Center and gift it to the Village to be constructed in Reservoir Lake Park; and

WHEREAS, the donation of the potential community (indoor recreation) center was discussed at the regular session meeting of Village Council on August 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS the plans, drawings, location, size, and footprint along with any provisions and conditions of the donation of the INDOOR COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER have been shared with, reviewed, evaluated and discussed by Village Council. See ORC 755.19 which reads:

ORC Section 755.19 \(\sum\_{care}\) of property donated for park purposes.

In any municipal corporation which is the owner or trustee of property for park purposes, or of funds to be used in connection therewith, by deed of gift, devise, or bequest, such property or funds shall be managed and administered in accordance with the provisions or conditions of such deed of gift, devise, or bequest.

WHEREAS, after a thorough review and evaluation of the plans, drawings, location, size, and footprint of the proposed donation of the Community Recreation Center along with any provisions or conditions, the Village Council desires to:

- 1) Authorize the construction of the building in Reservoir Lake Park; and
- 2) Approve the location of the structure/building; and
- 3) Agree that the Community Recreation Center shall be managed and administered in accordance with the provisions or conditions of such gift/donation; and
- 4) Designate the donated structure as the COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO:  $(ORC\ 731.18)$ 

SECTION 1. <u>AUTHORIZATION</u>. That Village Council hereby authorizes the construction, donation and dedication of an INDOOR CIVIC COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER within Reservoir Lake Park

SECTION 2. LOCATION. That the specific location of the building/structure is authorized to be constructed at the following location and subject to the ongoing approval of the Village Administrator:

SECTION 3. PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS OF GIFT/DONATION. (ORC 715.19) That the Mayor, Village Administrator, and Village Council have been made aware of any provisions or conditions of such gift/donation and agree that the INDOOR COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER shall be managed and administered in accordance with the provisions or conditions of such gift/donation as required by ORC 715.19.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATION. That in accordance with Sections 715.21 and 755.12 and the donated building structure shall be designated as follows:

#### **COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER**

SECTION 5. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [ORC 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 6. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to ORC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

# Village Officials report that the donor is ready to proceed with construction.

SECTION 7. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at

	all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
	WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
