Ordinances regarding payment to Driven Excavating should be passed tonight so we can get that done, mentioned rough treatment by vendor to push for quicker payment.

We were awarded the Ohio Law Enforcement Association agency of the month for the entire state. Mentioned the criteria that were met to claim that award. Looking at getting some more traffic signs, we did qualify for a free sign for speed control. It was suggested that it go along Townsend Avenue with the school out that way.

Mayor:

Legislation:

Emergency

Ordinance 2026-O-13 a declared emergency ordinance establishing a fund for a New Sewer Improvement Line Item was passed and adopted.

Ordinance 2026-O-14 a declared emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and amending the 2026 permanent appropriations for Sewer Improvement Lift Station was passed and adopted.

Resolution 2026-R-03 a Resolution Adopting a Cybersecurity Program was passed and adopted on Third Reading.

Resolution 2026-R-08 a Resolution Authorizing the Village Administrator to enter into a written agreement with the Huron County EMA for renewal was passed and adopted on Third Reading.

Resolution 2026-R-09 Public Records Training Designee(s) (Sunshine) was passed and adopted on Third Reading.

Old Business:

Mayor spoke to the situation regarding the rental lot that we were keeping our recycling bin located. We may move it to the area that is correct for the leasing that is already in existence.

New Business:

I have been in conversation with Travis Earhart, and he would like to work for the village. He does live here and would like to go to Linesman School, whether we would pay for it or not, he still wants to work for us @ \$ 21.00 per hour. I didn't promise anything to him but wanted to run it by council. Lynne Phillips made a motion that Travis Earhart be hired, Jason Hunter 2nd, 6 ayes.

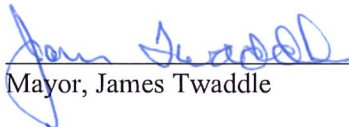

ENTERED INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION: ORC 121.22 (G)

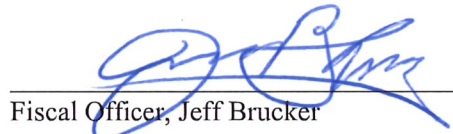
Lynne Phillips made motion to adjourn, Randal Stephens 2nd, 6 ayes.
