Resolution 2026-R-13 for Reservoir Lake Park Recreation Center User Agreement, Rental Forms, and Fee Schedule was approved for First Reading.

The location of the Recycle Bin needs to be established, the mayor suggested a few different options for consideration, it has to be moved due to current location not being land that we are leasing, it was established that the new administrator would be able to make that decision tomorrow.

New Business:

Electric rate study check was done by the mayor, it has been started, but not sure where it all stands.

Mayor will address the current Cemetery Sexton with update on his employment termination.

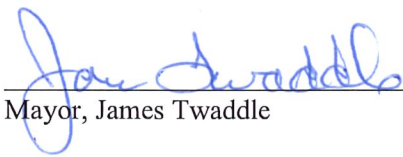
