Approval of prior meeting minutes

Randy Wilson made a motion to approve meeting minutes for council meeting from June 16th, 2026, Jason Hunter 2nd, 6 ayes.

Invited Guests / Comments from floor:

Mayor Twaddle shared some information about meeting guidelines, mainly related to the open forum rules. Karen wanted to thank the council for approving the trash receptacles, they were placed before the festivities, used and enjoyed by all. Sandy asked about time limits, usually 3 minutes from the floor, but not regulated.

Committee Meetings:

Park Committee : Jason talked about doner concessions working on a memorandum of understanding with the Solicitor, went over the Party in the Park set up and showed the tie-dyed shirts they'll be selling with patrons and America 250 pattern \$ 25.00 each, also cozies for \$ 3.00 or 2 for \$ 5.00, Meat Raffle went well, still owe Dalton Farms \$ 1,731.95, but we made \$ 1,366.05 which will be more money for the Park.

Administrator's report:

We have been doing some valve replacements to get ahead of some of the issues that had been happening, did Market Street, saved some money over what was projected, just last week we had the water quality report for 2025 and that will be shared in the coming utility bill, we also did some plant maintenance for some of the pumps. We are aware of the Seminary Street leaking, and it is on a long list of valves needing repaired or replaced. We'll be moving forward with some valve replacements on Tilton Street.

Fiscal Officer report:

Necessary fund movements for payroll in the OPERS category, all were done intra-fund, went over CD's we have, next one is maturing on November 19th, 2026, the weighted average for interest rate is 3.92 %, I will keep you informed as things move forward with those, we would like to see some better investment options, there are limits, but it doesn't all need to be in CD's.

Police Chief:

The festival went great, we had 3 EMS calls, and one private property crash, I would consider that a success. I also was called down to Jeff's office to receive a check from one of the villagers, and attached with it was a note that read "it's great living in a small town where help arrives so fast, thank you for all the help you have given us" so that was very nice. We have Cops and Bobbers coming up August 29th, 2026, back at the lake with water and hot dogs like last year, 10-1.

Solicitor:

Your senior project engineer would like to get moving on to the 2026 paving project and he's asking that you adopt the legislation.

Mayor:

Mentioned how the check that the Police Department received was a sign of how people feel they are being treated in the village, asked chief about the scrap cruiser, and he has been checking things with Steve about donation or what can be done with it. In addition, he would like to add that everyone has done a wonderful job getting ready for the festival and all around the village.

Legislation:

Resolution 2026-R-14 a declared emergency resolution authorizing the Village Administrator to make a written contract with OHM Advisors for professional services related to the 2026 Paving Program was passed and adopted.

Ordinance 2026-O-16 for Cemetery Sexton/Board of Trustees was approved for Second Reading.

Resolution 2026-R-13 for Reservoir Lake Park Recreation Center User Agreement, Rental Forms, and Fee Schedule was approved for Second Reading.

Old Business:

The location of the Recycle Bin was established in a more visible space, still near the railroad tracks. Jordon has interviewed some people and would like to hire Kevin Hicks as a part-time utility worker.

New Business:

Dorene Beverly made a motion to hire Kevin Hicks, Lynne Phillips 2nd, 6 ayes.

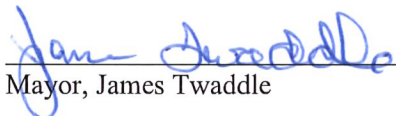

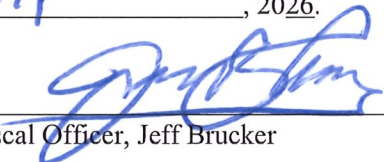
