A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH AARON D. BACK FOR **WEB SITE SUPPORT AND ADA COMPLIANCE** FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer reports that the village website will need to be Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant by 2027; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer further reports that the Village could benefit from website support services; and

WHEREAS the Fiscal Officer advises that the Village has received a proposal for website support; and

WHEREAS, in those villages that have established the position of village administrator, the village administrator shall make contracts, purchase supplies and materials, and provide labor for any work under the administrator's supervision involving not more than fifty thousand dollars. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code]

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (ORC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Village Council finds it is necessary to provide the following services:

Website Support including Federal ADA compliance

SECTION 2. That Council finds that the following has submitted the lowest and best proposal and is a company/business/professional qualified to furnish the labor, service, and equipment necessary to satisfy the requirements of the agreement:

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZATION. That the VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR is hereby authorized and directed to a written Agreement with the terms of the following proposal/quote/estimate ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE:

SECTION 4. That the contract shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [Section 731.141 of the Ohio Revised Code]

SECTION 5. DURATION. That the Agreement is hereby authorized for a term of:

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From 01/01/2026 until 12/31/2026 for one (1) calendar year - 2026

SECTION 6. AMOUNT. That the amount of the contract shall not exceed the following:

\$2,000.00 for year 2026

SECTION 7. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
