A FINAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE MULTI-USE PATH TRAIL SURFACE IMPROVEMENTS

The following Final Resolution enacted by the Village of Greenwich, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of November, 2025, the LPA enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project [*See Resolution No.: 2025-R-44*]

The project consists of the construction of a multi-use path from Alpha Rd in Greenwich Township to Town Line 79 in London Township and trail surface improvement from Townsend Street to N. Kniffin Street including asphalt concrete surfacing, curb ramp, 4" concrete walk, bikeway rails, guardrail upgrades, signing, and pavement markings, lying within the Village of Greenwich; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The Village agrees to assume and bear one Hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the village limits, less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation.

In view of the fact that the LPA's share of the project is now estimated in the amount of **Zero and - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$0.00)**, therefore, the Village will not be required to deposit any funds at this time. The LPA's ultimate share of the cost will be determined when final actual costs and allocations are determined.

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of the same to this legislative authority; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (*ORC 731.18*)

SECTION 1. That the LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

SECTION 2. That the LPA enter into a contract with the State, and that the Village Administrator be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract for improving the described project.

SECTION 3. That the LPA transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

The Fiscal Officer is hereby instructed and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution with the original record thereof, found in the record of the proceedings of the LPA, and which Resolution was duly passed by the LPA on the 7th day of April, 2020, and that the same is a true and correct copy of the record of said Resolution and the action of said LPA thereon to ODOT.

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [ORC 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to ORC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

In an email to the Greenwich Fiscal Officer on March 31, 2020, ODOT District 3 LPA Coordinator advised that legislation would need to be completed at the 4/7 meeting if at all possible to keep this project on track.

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
