AUTHORIZATION Garbage and Solid Waste Disposal ORC 3707.43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A WRITTEN AGREEMENT FOR **GARBAGE AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL** AND ACCEPTING THE BID/PROPOSAL OF **RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC** AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 715.43 permits the village to provide for the collection of garbage; and

Section 715.43 | Refuse disposal.

Any municipal corporation may provide for the collection and disposition of sewage, garbage, ashes, animal and vegetable refuse, dead animals, and animal offal, and may establish, maintain, and regulate plants for the disposal thereof.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 3707.43 permits the Village to contract for the removal of garbage; and

Section 3707.43 | Contract for removal of waste substances - expense.

The legislative authority of a municipal corporation may contract for a period of not to exceed five years for the collection and removal of the garbage, night soil, dead animals, and other solid waste substances mentioned in section 3707.42 of the Revised Code at the expense of the municipal corporation or at the expense of persons responsible for the existence of such waste substances.

WHEREAS, The Village contracts with a private hauler for the collection and disposal of garbage and rubbish from both residential and commercial occupancies. See EDITOR'S NOTE in CHAPTER 1060, Garbage and Rubbish Collection and Disposal of the CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF GREENWICH, OHIO; and

WHEREAS, Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances Section 1060.02(a) requires the use of a collector hired by the village which reads:

1060.02 COLLECTION; FEES.

(a) Each owner or person having control and possession of a building or premises used for residential purposes, including multifamily dwellings consisting of four residential units or less, shall provide and ensure that all garbage and rubbish is removed from such building or premises not less than once each week by the garbage collector hired by the Village, or by such other method as may be approved by Council, in accordance with recognized health and sanitary standards and regulations.

WHEREAS, the Village currently contracts with RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC for Solid Waste Collection and Removal of Garbage authorized most recently by Resolutions Nos: 2021-R-09 and 2025-R-23; and

WHEREAS, the current written agreement for Village Garbage and Solid Waste Disposal is set to expire on May 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Village advertised and received Bids for Garbage and Solid Waste Disposal services; and

WHEREAS, sealed Bids were publicly opened and read on May 6, 2026 at 6:45pm in Village Council Chambers; and

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WHEREAS, the Mayor advises that RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC is the LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE bidder [See Greenwich Code Section 206.02]; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (ORC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Council finds it is necessary to continue to provide the following services:

GARBAGE AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

SECTION 2. ACCEPT PROPOSAL. That Council finds that the following has submitted the LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE Bid/Proposal as defined in Greenwich Code Section 206.02:

RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement (**WASTE DISPOSAL CONTRACT**) consistent with the following terms:

(SEE WASTE DISPOSAL CONTRACT ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE)

SECTION 4. EXECUTION. That the contract shall be executed in the name of the village and signed on its behalf by the village administrator. [ORC 731.141 and Section(s) 232.01 and 232.09 of the Greenwich Code]

SECTION 5. DURATION. That the Agreement is hereby authorized for a term of:

Three (3) years 06/01/2026 through 05/31/2029
With Options for years 4 and 5. (06/01/2030 through 05/31/2031)

SECTION 6. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. [ORC 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2)]

SECTION 7. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to ORC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

The current contract expires May 31, 2026

SECTION 8. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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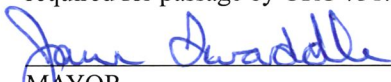
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WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

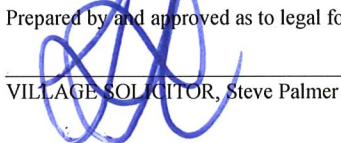

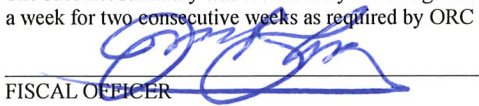
