FEES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1062.12 OF THE GREENWICH CODIFIED MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING GREENLAWN CEMETERY FEES

WHEREAS, as permitted by Section 759.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village of Greenwich owns, operates and maintains Greenlawn Cemetery, a public burial ground; and

WHEREAS, Greenlawn Cemetery is properly registered pursuant to Section 4767.03 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 759.03 of the Ohio Revised Code permits the legislative authority of a municipal corporation owning a public burial ground or cemetery within or without the municipal corporation, to pass ordinances necessary to provide for, and regulate the cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenwich established regulations for the Greenlawn Cemetery passed and adopted by Ord. No.: 628, passed 08-03-1976 and codified in Chapter 1062 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Greenlawn Cemetery Regulations contained in Chapter 1062 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code were most recently repealed and replaced by Ord. No.: 2022-20, passed January 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Greenlawn Cemetery fees are set by Greenwich Code Section 1062.12 which currently reads:

G.C. 1062.12 FEES.

(a) The fee charged for a grave space in Greenlawn Cemetery will be three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) per space for a resident of the Village. As used in this subsection, "resident" means only those persons living within the Village corporation limits. Any person wishing to purchase space in Greenlawn Cemetery who does not reside within the Village corporation limits will pay five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per space.

(b) The fee for opening and closing graves shall be as follows:

(1) Standard Monday - Friday Five hundred fifty dollars (\$550.00).

(2) Saturday Six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$625.00).

(3) Sunday and holiday Seven hundred dollars (\$700.00).

(c) There will be a charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for any deed done in duplicate or for any deed done because of a transfer of the grave space to another person.

(d) The fee for the processing, handling, and interment, of a single urn shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

WHEREAS, the current vendor/subcontractor for grave digging has notified the Village of a price increase effective Jan. 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Cemetery Committee of the Village Council has reviewed the current fees and recommends that the cemetery fees be amended to account for the increase in interment expenses; and

WHEREAS the cemetery fees were most recently amended by Ord. No.: 2018-O-07 and again by Ord. No.: 2024-O-33, passed December 30, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO:
(ORC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Section 1062.12 of the Greenwich Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances regarding Greenlawn

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Cemetery Fees is hereby amended as follows:

1062.12 FEES.

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(b) The fee for opening and closing graves shall be as follows:

(1) Standard Monday - Friday ~~Five hundred fifty dollars (\$550.00)~~ \$650.00

(2) Saturday ~~Six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$625.00)~~ \$700.00

(3) Sunday and holiday ~~Seven hundred dollars (\$700.00)~~ \$800.00

(c) There will be a charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for any deed done in duplicate or for any deed done because of a transfer of the grave space to another person.

(d) The fee for the processing, handling, and internment, of a single urn shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS. That any amendments herein are indicated with additions appearing in **bold and underline** and deletions appearing in **bold-and-strikethrough**.

SECTION 3. CODIFICATION. That the Fiscal Officer / Council Clerk is hereby instructed and directed to submit the amendments contained herein to the codification and publication service for the Village.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

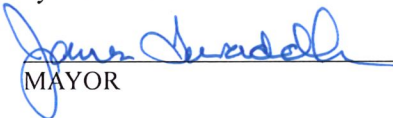
WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
