SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE ORC 5705.38

AN ORDINANCE MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING 12/31/2026 AND AMENDING THE 2026 PERMANENT APPROPRIATION MEASURE ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Fiscal Officer reports that Village Council previously passed Ordinance No.: 2026-O-06 titled PERMANENT APPROPRIATION MEASURE setting the annual appropriations for the year and providing for the current expenses and other expenditures of the village; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.38(A) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that during the year the taxing authority of the subdivision may pass any supplemental appropriation measures as it finds necessary; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.40 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that any appropriation ordinance or measure may be amended or supplemented; and

WHEREAS, Section 705.18 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that supplemental appropriations shall not be made during the current fiscal year unless by an ordinance passed as an emergency measure; and

WHEREAS, an ordinance by village council is necessary when the appropriation amendment will result in a reallocation of the line-item amounts approved in the village's permanent appropriation ordinance [See Village Officer's Handbook, March 2019, Chapter Six: Accounting Procedures, Section IX Amending Appropriations. (Page 6-12)]; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer reports that the amendment(s) and supplement(s) herein are measures providing for appropriations for the current expenses of the village and should go into immediate effect pursuant to section 731.30 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer specifically reports that:

"Our revenue and appropriations budget were not in line with the OWDA project, and we need to create emergency legislation to match the recent changes I put forth to the County."

See AMENDED OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES dated May 22, 2026, for fiscal year beginning January 1st, 2026, as revised by the Huron County Budget Commission. See ORC 5705.39

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWICH, STATE OF OHIO: (ORC 731.18)

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SECTION 1. That Council finds it necessary to make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending 12/31/2026 and to amend the Permanent Appropriation Measure Ordinance No.: 2026-O-06 as follows:

Increase Revenue:

5202-923-5209 OWDA Loans Issued (Phase 4)

\$ 1,876,600.00

and

5202-923-5211 Army Corp of Engineers Loans

\$ 925,000.00

Increase Appropriation:

5202-800-510-5209 Land and Land Improvements (Phase 4)

\$ 2,801,600.00

All totaling the projected amount of \$2,801,600.00 in both revenue and appropriations.

SECTION 2. That the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to obtain an amended certificate of funds from the County Auditor to reflect the additional appropriations, and the amended appropriations amended herein shall not be effective until receipt.

SECTION 3. IMMEDIATE EFFECT. [ORC 731.30] That measures providing for the appropriations for the current expenses of the municipal corporation shall go into immediate effect.

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. [ORC 731.17(A)(2)] That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

To provide for the amended appropriations of the current expenses of the Village.

The Fiscal Officer further reports that this will need to be "an emergency legislation" due to the status of payment needed by our payees.

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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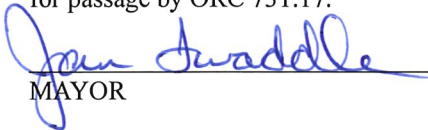
WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

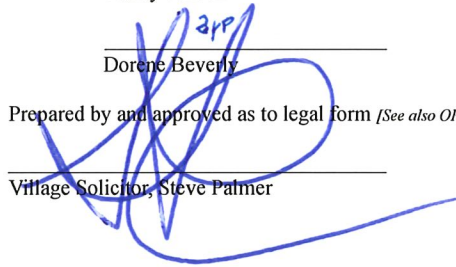

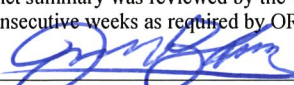
